ATV Safety & Offences

The Beauval Detachment has been receiving complaints regarding ATV Traffic within the town limits of Beauval driving erratically. This is a reminder that drivers under the age of 16 cannot operate an ATV in the Village of Beauval and you must have a VALID DRIVER's LICENSE to operate an ATV. You must also wear a helmet when driving one.

Should the RCMP encounter anyone not following the noted laws, the ATV may be towed at the owner's expense. If anyone witnesses an incident and wishes to report the matter, please contact our detachment

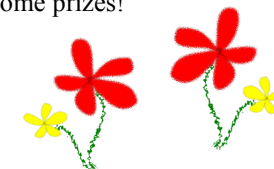

Best Grilled Pork Chops

This is a simple recipe. It is simple to throw together the marinade in the morning before going off to work and come home to an easy dinner to prepare in the evening.

Ingredients

1/2 cup water
1/3 cup light soy sauce
1.4 cup vegetable oil
3 tbsp. lemon pepper seasoning
2 tsp minced garlic
6 boneless pork loin chops, trimmed of fat

Directions

1. Mix water, soy sauce, vegetable oil, lemon pepper seasoning and minced garlic in a deep bowl. Add pork chops and marinate in the fridge for at least 2 hours.
2. Preheat an out door grill for medium-high heat and lightly oil the grate.
3. Remove pork chops from the marinade and shake off excess. Discard the marinade.
4. Cook the pork chops on the preheated grill until no longer pink in the center. About 5 to 6 minutes per side.
